## Guild Workshop

### Workshop Supply List

1. A printed copy of the *Blowing In the Wind* Pattern or *Somewhere* Pattern
2. Fabric for the project
3. You will need a set of Applipop's Circle Design Template rings. or Prefused Circles Cut using an Accuquilt die cutter, or Handcut prefused circles
4. Roxanne's Glue Baste
5. A small iron - I recommend the Oliso Mini Iron
6. A wool pressing mat is recommended but any pressing service will work.
7. A wooden dressmaker's clapper.
8. A bottle of Mary Ellen's Best Press.
9. A small sharp pair of scissors - I recommend Karen Kay Buckley's blue and/or lime green handles scissors.
10. A very thin (100 weight) thread in a neutral color for applique - I recommend Wonderfil's Invisafil in gray.  
Also for *Blowing in the Wind* you will need a thick thread (28=40 weight) in either Black or White for making the stems from the bubbles to the flower center. In my quilt I used black 28wgt. Aurifil.

- 11.** A sewing machine in good working order that you are familiar with using and basic sewing supplies.
- 12.** An area to layout your work either design wall or table top area. A piece of Foam Core works great for this.
- 13.** A stylus, stiletto, purple thing, or awl.
- 14.** Thermal thimbles,
- 15.** Pellon SF 101. 3/4 to 1 1/4 yards.

**You can make the class move a little quicker with some precutting.**

**Your Fusible webbing if you chose to do fusible raw-edge applique can be any brand you enjoy using. My recommendation is Hot Fix Fusible.**

## Blowing In the Wind Fabric Requirements & Circle Cutting Chart

### Fabric Requirements:

NOTE: If you are doing a rainbow halo of Flower tip circles the total amount of fabric for the Flower Tip Circles needs to total 1/3 - 3/8 yard. Scraps that will total this amount is enough. About 100 - 2 1/2" squares.
