At the October mentoring class we will be making a Holiday Star which is a 3-D star ornament which can be made for any time (season or holiday) of the year. It looks rather complicated, but like the 3-D Pinwheel, it is actually easy and fast to make.

Basic sewing supplies:

Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat
Scissors, straight pins, thread
Hand needle

You will also need a button for the center of your star.

Fabric

We will be making the Medium 6-Pointed Star.

You will need two different materials (one for front of star and one for back and trim).

Main fabric – 3 1/2” x WOF

Trim – 1/4 yard

You will also need **fusible interfacing** (911F). 12” x 20” rectangle

Please try to have your materials cut and complete step one before class. Ignore any and all reference to the 8-pointed star.

Cutting and Prep

Medium 6-pointed star

Main (3) 3 1/4” x 6 1/2” Front strips

Trim (2) 1 1/4” by WOF
(3) 3 1/4” x 9 1/2” Back strips

Interfacing (3) 3 1/4” x 6 1/2” Front strips
(3) 3 1/4” x 9 1/2” Back strips

Fuse Interfacing strips to corresponding Front Strips and Back Strips. Set aside extra interfacing strips to be used later.
