

## September - Mentor Classes 3 – D Pinwheel Table Runner Supply List

Thursday, September 20 – 6:15pm for setup

At the September mentoring class we will be making a 3-D Pinwheel table runner. It looks really complicated, but it's actually easier and faster to make than a traditional flat pinwheel block.

### Basic sewing supplies:

sewing machine  
rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat  
scissors, straight pins, thread

### Fabric →

1/3 yard of two fabrics for **background** and the **pinwheels**.

Cut three 11" squares from each material.

NOTE: the squares will be further cut in class.

15" pieces of material WOF for **sashing, borders** and **binding**

Cute three 2 ¼ " strips from the material for **binding**.

Cut three 2" strips from the material for sashing and borders.

Cut two of these strips down to 35" for top and bottom borders.

Cut two 10 ½" x 2" pieces from third 2" strip for side borders.

Cut two more 10 ½" pieces for sashing. These will be cut down to 10 ½" x 1 ½".

**Flange is optional** – if you want a flange, you will need 1" pieces of material cut the same lengths as borders pieces
