- Your name must be on the back of the quilt. Quilt labels are preferred.
- Place your quilt in a pillowcase or other fabric bag with your name on the bag. One quilt per bag.
No plastic or paper bags.

Quilt Spectrum Categories • Quilts are defined as having 3 layers: top, batting, and backing.

PIECED QUILTS – LONGARMED the majority (51% or more) of the quilt is constructed using traditional techniques, patterns and inspirations from existing quilt history. The quilt is quilted on a longarm machine. This category may be subdivided into 2 or 3 size groups depending on the number of entries received.

PIECED QUILTS – DOMESTIC same as above, only the quilt has been quilted on a domestic machine.

HAND-QUILTED QUILTS the majority (51% or more) of the quilt is hand-quilted.

MODERN QUILTS should follow the general modern guidelines of using negative space, simplicity of design, asymmetry, and bold colors.

PANEL QUILTS the majority (51% or more) of the front of the quilt is a panel.

CHALLENGE (2025 – 2026) quilts created to depict this year's guild theme of 'The Magic of Quilting'.

HAAQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH (2025 - 2026) quilts made during the 2025-2026 'My Home and Yours' block of the month with HAAQG.

YOUTH QUILTS constructed and bound by a child who is a high school senior or younger, and no older than 19. They may be quilted by someone other than the youth. Youth entries should be sponsored by a guild member.

MACHINE EMBROIDERED / EMBELLISHED / APPLIQUED / WOOL – COTTON QUILTS have 3-dimensional additions which the majority (51% or more) are done by machine, such as embroidery, applique, fabric manipulation, beads, sequins, fibers, etc., regardless of the fabric used. Examples of fabric manipulation would include folds, yo-yo's, cathedral windows, ragged edges.

HAND EMBROIDERED / EMBELLISHED / APPLIQUED / WOOL – COTTON QUILTS same as above, only the majority (51% or more) is done by hand.

GROUP QUILTS the person entering the quilt is a HAAQG member who has constructed the quilt top consisting of blocks or other elements made by others.

POTPOURRI is any item that does not fit into the other categories. Examples could be a tree skirt, clothing, Christmas stocking, purses, hats, thread catchers, home décor, or anything made with fabric and thread, regardless of the fabric used. If necessary, entrant must provide tabs or other method on the back of their piece so that the committee can easily hang it at the show.

MINIATURE QUILTS are constructed quilts but in miniature. Dimensions should be no larger than 24" per side and no more than 4" per block.

INVITATIONAL QUILTS are 2025's first place winners or presidential quilts and are on display only.
