

February Mentor Class -Twister Pinwheel

February 20, 2020 – Setup 6:15 – Start sewing 6:30

Have fun creating continuous pinwheels using one of the new rulers. The new ruler simplifies this old favorite with an easy, fun and fast technique. You can use a charm pack, get a kit from Kay or bring your own 5" squares.



Basic sewing supplies:

sewing machine
rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat
scissors, straight pins, seam ripper, thread

Fabric:

fabric for pinwheels – nine 5" squares
fabric for inside border – 1/4 yard (mine is white)
fabric for outside border & binding – 1/2 yard
fabric for back – 22" square
OR get a kit from Kay -- \$5.00

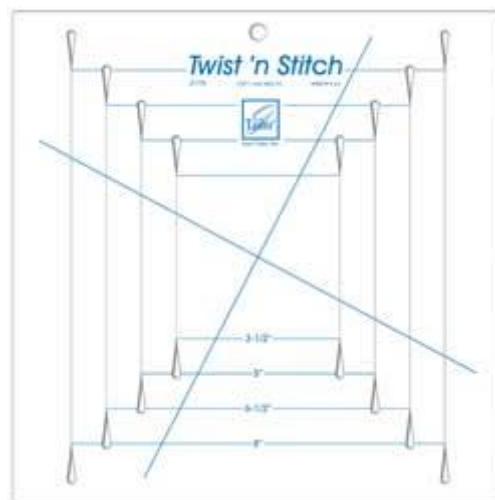
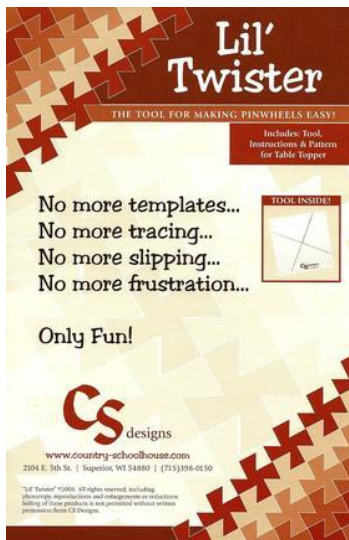
The ruler is **OPTIONAL** →Lil' Twister ruler for 5" squares

June Taylor Twist 'n Stitch ruler JoAnn Fabrics)

Kay will have both of these rulers that you can use.

I can make-up a kit that will contain nine 5" squares and inside border (email me if you would like a kit). You will need fabric for outside border, binding and backing.

If you have taken the class before, you can bring however many 5" squares as you want plus the inside border. If this is your first one, I recommend doing just nine to learn the technique.



There is a new ruler by June Taylor called the **Twist 'n Stitch**. It does multiple size squares whereas the Lil' Twister just does 5" squares. The Treadle and JoAnn Fabrics carries the Twist 'n Stitch ruler. If you do not want to purchase a ruler until you have tried the technique, I will have several to share.
