

**Basic Class Materials:**

- Sewing machine and extra needles
- Medium size cutting mat (18"x24") or trim and press mat
- Rotary cutter – 28mm is best for foundation piecing
- Quilting ruler (1"x12" or larger suggested)
- Small scissors for clipping threads
- Paper scissors
- Quality piecing thread to match fabric
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
- Pencil and paper
- Elmer's Disappearing Washable Purple Glue
- Add A Quarter ruler 6 inch or 12 inch (12 inch recommended)
- Small travel iron (optional)

## Equinox

### Class prep:

Listed below are fabric yardages and cut list for Equinox.

Please cut and label prior to class.

### Fabric Yardage

**\*\*Please note\*\*** The yardage listed below allows for extra in case of accidents. The colors listed below represent the actual colors used in my Equinox. I have included a drawing that you can color to come up with different color ideas. You may make multiple copies of this drawing.

- 2 3/4 yard White/Cream (Background Fabric)
- 1/8 yard Light Brown (Leaf stems)
- 1 1/4 yard Brown/Multi Color Batik (Leaves)
- 1/4 yard Light Blue Batik
- 1/4 yard Yellow/Green Batik
- 1/3 yard Orange Batik
- 1/3 yard Blue/Purple Batik
- 1/3 yard Dark Orange Batik
- 1/3 yard Purple Batik

When cutting each block fabric, use self-adhesive notes to label each stack or cut squares from index cards. Label each stack as follows:

BD (Border Diamond) followed by Location #

LC (Log Cabin) followed by Block and Location #

ML (Maple Leaf) followed by Block and Location #

CML (Corner Maple Leaf) followed by Block and Location #

Dark Orange Batik – Fabric J

Purple Batik – Fabric K

White/Cream (Background)- Fabric B

- Cut 5 Strips 4 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>ML 1- 2B, ML 1- 3B</b>
<b>24 – 4 1/2" x 2"</b>

<b>ML 1- 5B, ML 1- 7B, ML 1- 9B, ML 1- 11B, ML 1- 13B, ML 1- 15B</b>
<b>72 – 4 1/2" x 2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 3" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>CML 1- 2B, CML 1- 3B</b>
<b>8 – 3" x 2"</b>

<b>CML 1- 5B, CML 1- 7B, CML 1- 9B, CML 1- 11B, CML 1- 13B, CML 1- 15B</b>
<b>24 – 3" x 2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 4 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>ML 2-2B, ML 2-3B</b>
<b>12 – 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" then cut (/) diagonally to make 24 HST</b>

<b>CML 2-2B, CML 2-3B</b>
4 – 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" then cut (/) diagonally to make 8 HST

- Cut 5 Strips 8" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 14B-17B</b>
48 – 8" x 4"

- Cut 1 Strip 8" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>ML Sashing 1</b>
12 – 8" x 2 1/2"

<b>CML Sashing 1</b>
4 – 5 1/2" x 2 1/2"

- Cut 1 Strip 9 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>ML Sashing 2</b>
12 – 9 1/2" x 2 1/2"

<b>CML Sashing 2</b>
4 – 6 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Brown/Multi Batik (Fabric A)

- Cut 3 Strips 4" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

12 – 4" x 4"

4 – 4" x 4"

- Cut 1 Strips 4" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>4 – 3" x 1 1/2"</b>

#### Light Blue Batik (Fabric D)

- Cut 2 Strips 3 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 1D</b>
<b>12 – 3 1/2" x 5 1/2"</b>

<b>LC – 1D</b>
<b>4 – 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"</b>

Yellow/Green Batik (Fabric E)

- Cut 1 Strip 5" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 2E, BD 3E</b>
<b>24 – 5" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 1 Strip 2 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 2E</b>
<b>4 – 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"</b>

<b>LC 3E</b>
<b>4 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"</b>

Blue Batik (Fabric F)

- Cut 1 Strip 5 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 4F, BD 5F</b>
<b>24 – 5 1/2" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 1 Strip 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 4F</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 4 1/2"</b>

<b>LC 5F</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 5 1/2"</b>

Orange Batik (Fabric G)

- Cut 1 Strip 6" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 6G, BD 7G</b>
<b>24 – 6" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 6G</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 5 1/2"</b>

<b>LC 7G</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 6 1/2"</b>

### Blue/Purple Batik (Fabric H)

- Cut 1 Strip 7" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 8H, BD 9H</b>
<b>24 – 7" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 8H</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 6 1/2"</b>

<b>LC 9H</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 8"</b>

### Dark Orange Batik (Fabric J)

- Cut 1 Strip 7 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 10J, BD 1J</b>
<b>24 – 7 1/2" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 10J</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 8"</b>

<b>LC 11J</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 9"</b>

### Purple Batik (Fabric K)

- Cut 1 Strip 8" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>BD 12K, BD 13K</b>
<b>24 – 8" x 1 1/2"</b>

- Cut 2 Strips 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

<b>LC 12K</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 9"</b>

<b>LC 13K</b>
<b>4 – 2" x 10"</b>

# David Gilleland / Vector Quilts Pattern Cutting Help Sheet

## Interpreting the cutting instructions:

**OBC A 7A**  
4 – 8 1/2" x 3 3/4"

- Cut 1 Strip 11 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

**CA 7A**  
4 – 11 1/2" x 4 3/4"

**CA/B 8A**  
8 – 11 1/2" x 2 1/4"

**Teal (Fabric C)**

- Cut 2 Strips 9" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

**OB A/B 1C**  
24 – 9" x 2 1/4"

**OBC B 7C**  
4 – 9" x 3 3/4"

- Cut 2 Strips 2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

**OBC A/B 8C**  
8 – 7 1/2" x 2"

- Cut 2 Strips 4 3/4" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

**CB 7C**  
4 – 11 1/2" x 4 3/4"

- Cut 1 Strip 5 1/2" x WOF
  - Sub Cut

**Inner Border Cornerstones**  
4 – 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Use teal or your choice of color but in this case, the color in all the cutting and associated labels is **C**.

Label the pile.

Cut 24 pieces that are 9" x 2 1/4"

In this example, you will have **24** pieces of **teal (or your color choice)** that are **9" x 2 1/4"** and the pile will be labeled **OB A/B 1C**. *These labels will make sense once you start your foundation piecing.* Contact Julie Mooberry if you have any questions.
