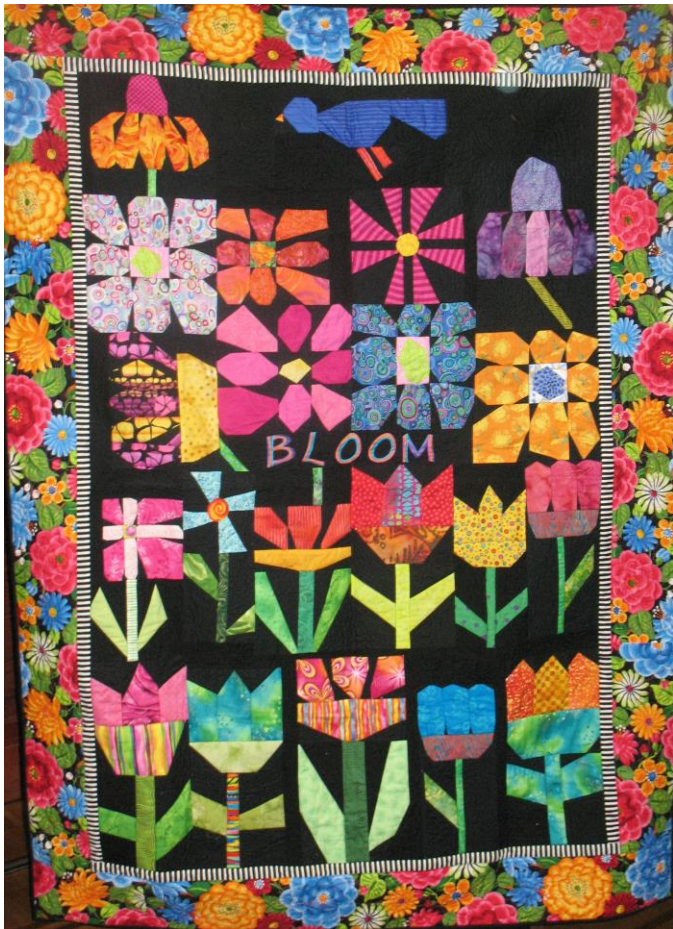


Flower Power

Supply List

Sewing Supplies

-
- Thread for machine sewing (to match your background)
- Straight pins
- Scissors
- A small mat, ruler 1 long one and one nice sized square and rotary cutter with a new blade
- Pencil and paper
- Anything YOU sew with when you are making a quilt that you might need

You will love the results and whimsical happy look of these quilts – no two are alike!

Fabrics

- Background – 2 ½ yards – Black really makes these pop, but any color that is not a medium value will work great.
 - Flowers – six to eight ¼ yard pieces of bright fun fabrics (this is your palette so you might want to bring more)
 - Bird – ¼ yard of pretty blue and another little piece 10" x 10" contrasting color-stripes make good tails
 - Leaves and stems – ¼ yard each of two different greens (different values) – make sure they show up well on your background
- All fabrics needed to create this quilt top.
