I promise they are very easy. Each kit will have enough fabric to make several blocks. The blocks are-four patches: Two rectangles sewn together for make a square
Half square triangles (you don't have to trim them)

Take kits for one, two, or all three types. I only ask that you sign out how many of each type of block kits you've taken, and you return them to me the following month. EASY!

A new year of giving and receiving is about to begin by offering our labors of love to groups and individuals within our community. This summer we received two large donations of fabric and other quilting goods. Ruth Pfaffmann's family friend, Glenn Hill, 510 Freeman Ave., Streamwood, IL 60107, gave a very large donation of material in June. His wife had died earlier in the spring and he gave her collection of fabric to several groups. The part we received was distributed at the June retreat. He would very much enjoy a note of thanks from some of our members to express their appreciation and what the material was used for. We also received a second donation of material, patterns, and magazines from a different person who has chosen to 'downsize' her sewing stash.

The Community Project Committee will again this year, collect similar projects as last year plus maybe a few new ones after we research them a little more. The pillow cases, Cancer Comfort Quilts, Baby Quilts, Fidgit Quilts, Receiving Blankets and Burp Cloths, and Valor Quilts will continue to be collected. This gives you a choice of a project for you to work on. Please pick up a handout at the Community Projects Table with all the sizes and descriptions of each project.

Our first large need is the same as last year. Nancy Stone is again collecting quilts for the 'Children without Beds' in our community. In September and October, we hope to collect 60 children's quilts 70" X 90" approximately. If you have additional material that matches the quilt, consider adding a pillow case with your gift. We already have 5 quilts toward our goal. ALL projects to be turned in these 2 (two) months, we would like you to KEEP with you at the meeting and show them ALL at one time when announced, then bring to the tables for drop off. Hopefully this will be a united way to show your support for community projects and also speed up our part of Show-n-Tell.

Thank you for your help ahead of time, in this new 'giving' year. Besides Carol Lou and myself, several other women have volunteered to be available as committee project helpers, Bev Elder, Kathy Hatch and Aleta Batty.
