## PROGRAMS

October 7, 2021. Jane Sassaman who is an internationally known quilt artist, fabric designer, author, and teacher ([janesassaman.com](http://janesassaman.com)) will present her lecture "Textile Treasure Garden " at 7 pm. We will meet at the church and view her program via Zoom. The business meeting and show 'n tell will follow her program.

Jane's Saturday class, "Suns and Moons" has three seats left. Her maximum per class is 20. Registration form is available at the meeting and on the website.

October 9, 2021. CLASS "Suns and Moons" with Jane Sassaman via Zoom. There is no pre-cutting of fabric to prepare for this class so you could still sign-up after the meeting October 7. This is a machine applique class based on the circle motif. Using Jane's applique techniques and experimenting with decorative stitches, you will begin by making a series of colorful fabric disks which will then be arranged into a dramatic and contemporary composition. Go to her website under 'workshops' to print the supply list. Those registered will receive additional information prior to the class.

November 4, 2021. Susan Knapp will be IN PERSON for our November meeting. Her lecture and trunk show, "Branching Out", will be at 7 pm. She will have her patterns and books available for purchase.

This year’s raffle quilt is named Doubly Charmed. Made from a Deb Tucker pattern, it measures 90” x 102”. The quilt was made with Grunge fabric by Moda, Silver and Off White So Fine thread, and Quilters Dream 100% cotton batting. Whirlywind motifs are quilted in three sizes throughout the quilt and a feather border. Quilt is complete with a hanging sleeve and label. White/gray grunge fabric used on the back accents quilting and could be reversible. We need volunteers to sell tickets at the Quilt show, this job would require lots of smiling and sitting, so if interested, see the sign-up genius for times available.

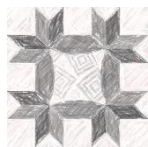

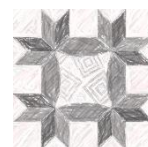
