The 2021 Quilt show is here. More than 4000 tickets have been sold prior to the show. If you have money and stubs for the big barrel, please let me know and we can arrange a meeting time and place. Don't forget the one who sells the winning ticket (if seller's name is on the back of the stub) will win a quilt carrier made also from the Deb Tucker pattern of the quilt. Good Luck!

We are in need of volunteers to sell tickets at the Quilt show, this job would require lots of smiling and sitting, so if interested, see SignUpGenius for times available.

This year's raffle quilt is named Doubly Charmed. Made from a Deb Tucker pattern, it measures 90" x 102". The quilt was made with Grunge fabric by Moda, Silver and Off White So Fine thread, and Quilters Dream 100% cotton batting. Whirlywind motifs are quilted in three sizes throughout the quilt and a feather border. Quilt is complete with a hanging sleeve and label. White/gray grunge fabric used on the back accents quilting and could be reversible.
